
AN EMENDATION TO GUNZO

In Gunzo's *Epistula <ad Augienses Fratres>*, there is a passage which reads thus in the text given in Martène et Durand, *Vet. Script. ampl. Coll.*, I, column 306 C :

*Limax in suo conclavi cornupeta sibi videtur,
Seque putat cursu timidis contendere damis.*

The first verse contains too many feet; in order to reduce it to regular proportions, J. Havet (*Œuvres*, 2. 67, quoted by Manitius, vol. II, p. 810, among the *Nachträge* to his earlier volume) emends the line thus :

Limax in concha sibi cornupeta esse videtur.

1. Invece nel *Placidus Librorum Romanorum* (C. G. L., V. 13. 13) *clandestinior res occulta.*
