### RENAISSANCE SCHOLARS IN AMERICA

The Renaissance Society of America, which its founders hope will bring together on a new principle all those scholars and patrons interested in the many aspects of Renaissance civilisation, was officially organized on January 30, at Columbia University, by representatives of leading American libraries, learned societies, and universities, with membership at about one thousand.

The Renaissance Society of America will unite the various fields of learning in order to study the Renaissance as a whole, thus rejoining art, history, literature, music, philosophy, religion, science, and all the other subjects now usually investigated separately. The new learned society will serve as the scholarly and professional organization all those patrons and scholars interested in the study of the Renaissance, as does the MEDIAEVAL ACADEMY those concerned with the study of mediaeval civilisation, according to Professor John H. Randall, Jr., of Columbia University, who is the president of the new Society.
