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## Clinics and pathology

### Disease

B-cell, precursor ALL

### Phenotype/cell stem origin

L1, CD10+/-, CD24+.

### Epidemiology

5 reported cases; Infant ALL, age 1.5-7 months at diagnosis.

### Prognosis

CR in all cases; 1 CNS relapse.

## Cytogenetics

### Cytogenetics morphological

t(5;15)(p15;q11-13).

### Cytogenetics molecular

Not done.

### Additional anomalies

+14; +22 one case each.
