



The « *Revue d'Écologie (La Terre et La Vie)* » is an international peer reviewed scientific journal published by the « *Société Nationale de Protection de la Nature et d'Acclimatation de France* » which is the dean of the world's societies for nature conservancy.

The « *Société impériale zoologique d'acclimatation* » founded in 1854 by Isidore Geoffroy Saint-Hilaire became in 1960 the « *Société Nationale de Protection de la Nature* », known by its acronym SNPN.

The journal « *La Terre et La Vie, Revue d'Histoire naturelle* » created in 1931, was renamed « *La Terre et La Vie, Revue d'Écologie appliquée* » in 1969, then « *Revue d'Écologie (La Terre et La Vie)* » in 1980.

This international journal of ecology will be entirely published online from 2015 onwards thanks to a partnership between SNPN and the « Institut de l'Information Scientifique et Technique (INIST) », a unit of the « Centre National de la Recherche Scientifique (CNRS) ».

It is published quarterly, has an editorial board, an impact factor and is abstracted and indexed in various data and bibliographic bases, e.g., Current Contents, ISI Web of Knowledge ASFA, Biological Sciences, Agriculture, Biology & Environmental Sciences, IBIDS, Journal of Citation Reports/Science Edition, OCLC, Scopus

It aims at publishing rapidly online, in French or in English, innovative studies covering all aspects of ecology: e.g., conservation biology; ecology of organisms, populations, communities and ecosystems; sensorial, physiological, behavioural and evolutionary ecology, etc.

Consultants of this website will find out further information about the journal in various complementary files and indices, e.g., instructions to authors, editorial board, etc.

All papers published since the beginning in 1932 will progressively be online in open access. This will make up a remarkable source of information for ecologists and other users across the world. However, downloading of more recent (less than fifteen years) papers is reserved to those who have subscribed for that at the SNPN.

The officers and the editorial board welcome you in this new website dedicated to scientific ecology. All your contributions will support the existence and evolution of this already long-lived « *Revue d'Écologie – La Terre et La Vie* ».
